Parents/carers are asked to visit the primary school of their choice during the Registration Week. If this isn't possible, parents/carers should try and visit the school by the end of February 2020.

To register for Primary 1, the child's birth certificate is required as evidence of their date of birth along with a proof of address (such as a utility bill or a bank statement).
